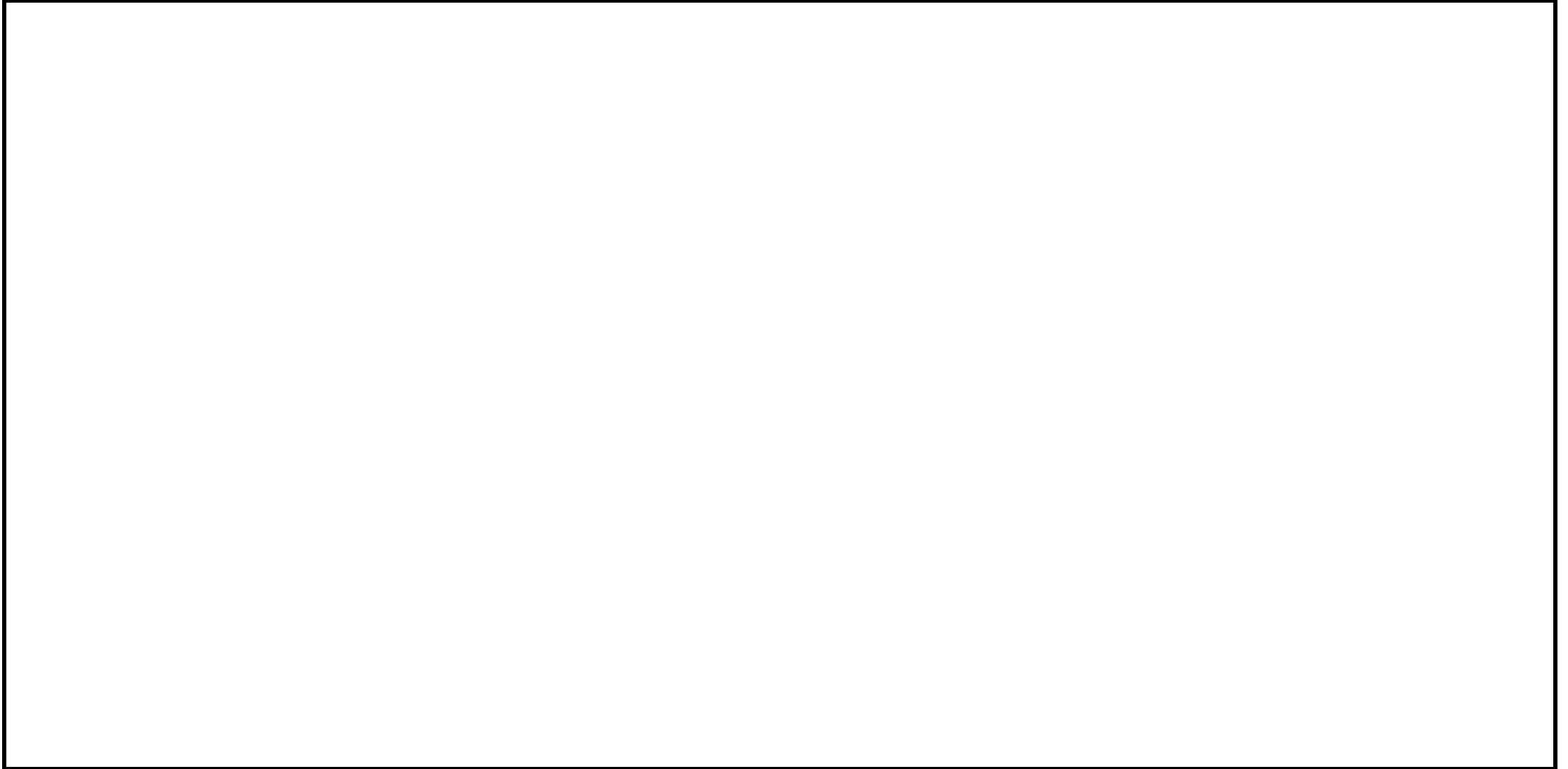

Accomplishments since July 1st, 2025

- Due to the topics on the June ballot, the Association experienced a record high election turnout. This resulted in over 70 new memberships, and a membership total of 246.
- On July 19th, the majority of the new Board voted in favor of supporting the draft Wake-Surf Ordinance, and notified the Township. On September 16th, Richmond unanimously voted to adopt it.
